
Dominion Energy Virginia: Industrial Rates Remain Extremely Competitive

Industrial Rate Comparison, average rate per kilowatt-hour, 1,000 kW demand and 650,000 kWh usage

As of January 2018, Dominion Energy Virginia's typical industrial rate is 14.9% below the Southeast Peer Group average, 24% below the CNBC "Top States for Business: 2017" average, 31.3% below the national average, 37.4% below the East Coast average, and 45.7% below the RGGI states average.




