
Dominion Energy Virginia ----- Competitive Industrial Rates

Industrial Rate Comparison, average rate per kilowatt-hour, 1,000 kW and 650,000 kWh usage

As of February 2020, Dominion Energy Virginia's typical industrial rate is 25.5% below the Southeast Peer Group average, 33.5% below the CNBC "Top States for Business: 2017" average, 39.9% below the national average, 45.2% below the East Coast average, and 52.5% below the RGGI states average.
